	 After-hours construction activities related to several large concrete pours at 10400 Fernwood Rd, Bethesda. The concrete pours must be accomplished as one continuous pour. Due to the volume of concrete involved, the work hours need to be expanded beyond the normal daytime hours (7:00 a.m. to 5.p.m.). This will help alleviate pedestrian safety impacts and traffic congestion related to the number of concrete trucks that must access the site. The work shall be performed under the following conditions: This Temporary Noise Waiver applies only to concrete pouring activities performed Monday to Friday from 3:30 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. No other after-hours work may be performed as part of this Temporary Noise Waiver. Trucks delivering concrete shall utilize a pull through traffic pattern to avoid backup alarm noise. All machinery utilized at this job site shall be outfitted with OSHA approved white noise back-up alarms. Approved non-tonal signaling methods may also be used. Trucks and related equipment shall be operated at the minimum power level necessary to complete the task in a safe manner. Only non-impact tools shall be used for after-hours precast panel installation work. All reasonable efforts should be made to perform the noisiest activities as early in evening as possible. Onsite communications shall be done without shouting. Machinery shall be inspected daily and equipped with proper noise attenuation measures to minimize construction noise, including, but not limited to well-maintained and effective mufflers. Maving parts shall be well lubricated to avoid unnecessary noise from squeaking parts. Machinery should be operated at the minimum level necessary to get the job done. Minimize banging, clattering, buzzing and other annoying types of noises. All in osite staff, including delivery truck drivers, should be notified of noise mitigation procedures prior to work. Minere possible, the local power grid should be used
