Application for Temporary Noise Waiver **For Distribution by July 12, 2024**

The Department of Environmental Protection is currently reviewing an application for a Temporary Noise Waiver as allowed under the Montgomery County Noise Control Ordinance, Chapter 31B, Section 11(a). The Department will receive comments on the application for a minimum of ten (10) days after distribution of this notice.

The Temporary Noise Waiver is being requested by Miller and Long Concrete of 7101 Wisconsin Ave, Bethesda. A large mobile crane will be used to remove the tower crane at 7316 Wisconsin Ave, Bethesda. The work requires the lengthy process of assembling a large mobile crane, removing the tower crane, and disassembling the mobile crane.

The work is scheduled to start on July 27th at 3:00 a.m. through July 28th at 9:00 p.m., weather and scheduling permitting.
