SUBJECT: Special Appropriation to the FY22 Operating Budget

Montgomery County Public Schools

\$252,242,245 for the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund III (Source of Funds: Federal Relief Grant - American Rescue Plan Act of 2021)

## **Background**

- 1. Section 308 of the County Charter provides that a special appropriation is an appropriation which states that it is necessary to meet an unforeseen disaster or other emergency, or to act without delay in the public interest. Each special appropriation shall be approved by not less than six Councilmembers. The Council may approve a special appropriation at any time after public notice by news release. Each special appropriation shall specify the source of funds to finance it.
- 2. The Board of Education has requested a special appropriation of \$252,242,245 for the Montgomery County Public Schools' FY22 Operating Budget for the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) III Fund. The ESSER III Fund was included in the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) that was signed into law on March 11, 2021. Under ESSER III, the U.S. Department of Education awarded grants to address the impact that the Novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) has had, and continues to have, on elementary and secondary schools across the nation.
- 3. The requested funds will be used to provide for:
  - Position salaries;
  - Non-position salaries;
  - Stipends;
  - Associated employee benefits;
  - Contractual services;
  - Special education compensatory services;
  - Instructional materials and technology support and resources.

Funds will be allocated as follows:
