Resolution 19-1285, Section G, Fiscal Year 2023 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award Status: The Primary Care Coalition of Montgomery County, Inc.

Background

- 1. Section 11B-14 (a) (4) of the Montgomery County Code states that "a contract may be awarded without competition if the Chief Administrative Officer makes a written determination that the contract award serves a public purpose and proposed contractor has been identified in a grant or appropriation resolution approved by the Council." The result of this action is to amend the FiscalYear (FY) 2023 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award status resolution to include the entities listed below.
- 2. The Chief Administrative Officer has determined that funding for the contracts with this entity serves a public purpose and that such an expense would be in the public interest.
- 3. The Department of Health and Human Services will fund the additional funding request for the contract with the entity listed below from grant funds in FY 2023.
- 4. The Department of Health and Human Services will increase the award of a contract with The Primary Care Coalition of Montgomery County, Inc. by \$65,000 for a revised award amount of \$140,118 for the purpose: "Provides community-based minority outreach and health education services (LHI)."

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:

The Council approves an amendment to the Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award and thereby amends Resolution 19-1285, Section G, FY23 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award. The Chief Administrative Officer has recommended this action and stated that this action serves a public purpose and is in the public interest.

The FY23 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award Status resolution is amended to:

1. Increase the amount of an existing award with The Primary Care Coalition of Montgomery County, Inc. by \$65,000 for a revised award amount of \$140,118 for the purpose: "Provides community-based minority outreach and health education services (LHI)."
