SUBJECT: Resolution to Extend Public Hearing Date for Zoning Text Amendment (ZTA) 23-08, Transferable Development Rights - Cemetery

Background

- 1. On November 7, 2023, the District Council introduced Zoning Text Amendment (ZTA) 23-08, Transferable Development Rights Cemetery.
- 2. Under Section 7.5.1. and 7.5.2.A. of the Zoning Ordinance, the District Council must publish a notice of the public hearing in at least 2 newspapers of general circulation in the County a minimum of 30 days before the hearing date.
- 3. The 30th day after November 7, 2023, would fall on December 7, 2023. Therefore, the District Council cannot hold a public hearing on ZTA 23-08 before December 7, 2023.
- 4. The Council will not be holding public hearings on Tuesday, December 12, 2023, its next Council hearing date after December 7, 2023.
- 5. Under Section 7.2.4.D. of the Zoning Ordinance, the District Council must hold a public hearing within 60 days after introduction, unless the District Council extends the hearing date.
- 6. The Council is on recess from December 18, 2023, through January 15, 2024.
- 7. The 60th day after November 7, 2023, would fall on January 8, 2024.

For these reasons, the County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that portion of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution: Page 2 Resolution No.: 20-315
