SUBJECT: Amendment to Fiscal Year 2025 Operating Budget
Montgomery County Government, Resolution 20-526, Section G,
Fiscal Year 2025 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award:
Little Falls Village Corp.

Background

1. Section 11B-14 (a) (4) of the Montgomery County Code states that “a contract may be awarded without competition if the Chief Administrative Officer makes a written determination that the contract award serves a public purpose and proposed contractor has been identified in a grant or appropriation resolution approved by the Council.” The result of this action is to amend the Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award status resolution to include the entities listed below.
2. The Chief Administrative Officer has determined that funding for the contract with this entity serves a public purpose and that such an expense would be in the public interest.
3. The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) will increase the award of an existing contract with Little Falls Village Corp. by \$65,302 for a revised award amount of \$99,675 for the purpose: “Provide for operating support.”
4. Funding for this action is available through the State American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) grant. No additional appropriation is necessary.

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:

The Council approves amendment to the Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award and thereby amends Resolution 20-526, Section G, FY25 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award. The Chief Administrative Officer has recommended this action and stated that this action serves a public purpose and is in the public interest.

The FY25 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award Status resolution is amended to reflect that DHHS will:

1. Increase the award of an existing contract with Little Falls Village Corp. by \$65,302 for a revised contract award amount of \$99,675 for the purpose: "Provide for operating support."
