SUBJECT: Executive Regulation 9-25, Systems Benefit Charges - Residential Waste Estimates

Background

1. Section 48-8A(b)(2)(A) of the County Code provides that the County Executive must establish by regulation the estimated amount of solid waste generated per dwelling unit. The estimate may consider the size of the dwelling unit.
2. On May 12, 2025, the County Council received Executive Regulation 9-25 from the County Executive. Regulation 9-25 establishes the calculated amount of solid waste generated per single-family and multi-family dwelling unit.

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves Executive Regulation 19-25, Systems Benefit Charges - Residential Waste Estimates.

Background: Montgomery County Code (2024), as amended, Section 48-8A(b)(2)(A), provides that the County Executive must establish by executive regulation the estimated amount of solid waste generated per dwelling unit and that the regulation may consider the size of the dwelling unit.

Section 1. Estimate of solid waste generation for calculation of the residential systems benefit charges. To calculate the residential systems, benefit charges, each single-family dwelling unit and each multi-family dwelling in a building, consisting of six or fewer dwelling units in the County, is estimated to produce 1.5777 tons per year of solid waste. Each dwelling unit in a building with seven or more dwelling units is estimated to produce .7502 tons per year of solid waste.
