SUBJECT: Approval of the Reappointment of the Inspector General

Background

1. Section 2-151 of the County Code establishes the Office of the Inspector General to:
 - a) review the effectiveness and efficiency of programs and operations of County government and independent County agencies;
 - b) prevent and detect fraud, waste, and abuse in government activities; and
 - c) propose ways to increase the legal, fiscal, and ethical accountability of County government departments and County-funded agencies.
2. Section 2-151 specifies that the Office of the Inspector General will be headed by an Inspector General.
3. Section 2-151 provides that the term of each Inspector General begins on July 1 of the third year after an Executive and Council are elected, and ends on June 30 of the third year after the next Executive and Council are elected. An Inspector General must not serve more than two full 4-year terms, not including any time served as Inspector General to complete an unexpired term.
4. Megan Davey Limarzi was appointed to fill the unexpired term of Edward Blansitt II from September 1, 2019, until June 30, 2021. Ms. Limarzi was appointed to her first full term from July 1, 2021, until June 30, 2025.

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:

Megan Davey Limarzi is reappointed to the position of Inspector General, in County pay grade IG, effective July 1, 2025, until June 30, 2029.
