SUBJECT: Resolution to Extend Time for Council Action on Executive Regulation 13-25,
Forest Conservation - Trees

Background

1. The Montgomery County Code mandates the Planning Board adopt regulations to administer Chapter 22A of the County Code under Method (2) of Section 2A-15. Section 2A-15 provides that to amend an existing regulation, the issuer must use the procedure under which the regulation was adopted.
2. On May 6, 2025, the County Council received Executive Regulation 13-25, Forest Conservation – Trees, submitted as a Method (2) regulation.
3. Along with a related proposed bill transmitted to the Council on May 6, 2025, Executive Regulation 13-25 would amend the existing regulations governing the Forest Conservation Law.
4. Under Method (2), the Council may approve, disapprove, or extend the time for action within 60 days of receiving the regulation. In the absence of Council action within 60 days, the regulation is deemed approved as submitted.

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:

The time for consideration of Executive Regulation 13-25, Forest Conservation - Trees, is extended to December 2, 2025.
