SUBJECT: Resolution to extend time for Council action on Executive Regulation 25-25,
Adoption of Context Sensitive Road Design Standards - Repeal

Background

1. The Council received Executive Regulation 25-25, Adoption of Context Sensitive Road Design Standards - Repeal, on May 18, 2026.
2. The Council received an updated version of Executive Regulation 25-25, Adoption of Context Sensitive Road Design Standards - Repeal, on June 1, 2026.
3. The regulation was submitted as a Method (2) regulation per Section 2A-15 of the County Code.
4. The Council must review the Executive regulation under Method (2) of Section 2A-15 of the County Code.
5. The Executive regulation under Method (2) automatically takes effect if the Council does not approve or disapprove an Executive regulation under Method (2) within 60 calendar days after the Council receives the regulation.
6. Section 2A-15 of the Count Code allows the Council to extend the deadline for action on an Executive regulation under Method (2).

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:

The time for consideration of Executive Regulation 25-25, Adoption of Context Sensitive Road Design Standards - Repeal, is extended until December 31, 2026.
