- (1) modify the duties and responsibilities of the Energy and Air Quality Advisory Committee;
- (2) change the name of the Energy and Air Quality Advisory Committee; and
- (3) generally revise County law regarding environmental sustainability.

By amending

Montgomery County Code Chapter 18A, Environmental Sustainability Sections 18A-1, 18A-5 and 18A-8.

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following Act:

Sec. 1. Sections 18A-1, 18A-5, and 18A-8 are amended as follows:

18A-1. Findings and statement of purpose.

(a) In the interest of maintaining an adequate and reliable energy supply at reasonable cost, the County government recognizes the need to institutionalize through legislation an energy policy and energy planning program. In addition, the efficient use of energy directly benefits air quality and climate, demonstrating the linkages necessary to achieve essential environmental goals. For this reason, the responsibilities of the Advisory Committee on Climate, Energy, [Conservation] and Air Quality includes [are expanded to include] an advisory function with respect to air quality and climate change.

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18A-5. <u>Climate</u>, Energy, and Air Quality Advisory Committee; establishment; terms of office; ex-officio members; etc.

(a) There is hereby established an Advisory Committee on Climate, Energy, and Air Quality to assist the County Council and the County Executive in carrying out the purposes of this [Article] Chapter and Chapter 3. The Committee consists of 15 members appointed by the [County] Executive, subject to confirmation by the [County] Council. One member must be designated by the Executive and confirmed by the Council to serve as chair of the Committee. Each appointee must be a resident of the County who is technically knowledgeable and interested in climate change, energy and air quality.

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18A-8. Duties and responsibilities.

The Committee has the following duties:
