22	An otherwise eligible business under Section 20-76E(c) that received a SBIR		
23	or STTR Phase I or Phase II grant between July 1, 2022, and the effective date of		
24	this Act that did not already apply for a County matching grant may still apply for a		
25	County matching grant during the current fiscal year.
