SUBJECT: Bill 10-24, Contracts and Procurement – Local Small Business Reserve Program –

Veteran Owned Business Preference Points – Established

PURPOSE: Introduction

Bill 10-24, Contracts and Procurement – Local Small Business Reserve Program – Veteran Owned Business Preference Points – Established, sponsored by Council President Friedson at the request of the Council Executive, is scheduled for introduction on April 16, 2024. A public hearing is before the Council and a worksession before the Government Operations and Fiscal Policy (GO) Committee will be scheduled at a later date.

BACKGROUND AND BILL SPECIFICS

Bill 10-24 seeks to establish a preference points system in the County's procurement program, in favor of local small businesses owned by veterans that meet certain criteria. According to the County Executive, Bill 10-24 seeks to enable veteran-owned local small businesses to gain access to more County procurement opportunities by awarding preference points of five percent to certified veteran-owned local small businesses that submit a proposal to a County RFP. To be eligible for these points a small business must have a valid Veteran-Owned Small Business (VOSB) or Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Businesses (SDVOSB) certificate from the U.S. Small Business Administration or the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs.

To be eligible for these points, a small business must have a valid Veteran-Owned Small Business (VOSB) or Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Businesses (SDVOSB) certificate from the U.S. Small Business Administration or the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs.
