AN EXPEDITED ACT to:

- (1) modify enforcement procedures by repealing the requirement for photographic evidence in complaints of gas-powered leaf blower use;
- (2) clarify that a single complaint may initiate enforcement of the gas-powered leaf blower ban; and
- (3) generally, amend the law regarding noise control.

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following Act:

Sec. 1. Sections 31B-2, 31B-9, and 31B-12 are amended as follows:

31B-2. Definitions.

* * *

Leaf blower means any portable device designed or intended to blow, vacuum, or move leaves or any other type of unattached debris or material by generating a concentrated stream of air. [Leafblower] <u>Leaf blower</u> includes devices or machines that accept vacuum attachments.

* *

31B-9. Leaf removal equipment.

- (a) Except as provided in this section, a person must not sell, buy, offer for sale, or use a [leafblower] <u>leaf blower</u> at any time that has an average sound level exceeding 70 dBA at a distance of 50 feet. This requirement is in addition to any other noise level or noise disturbance standard that applies under this Chapter.
- (b) An individual who owns or occupies a residence in a residential noise area may use at the individual's residence a [leafblower] <u>leaf blower</u> bought or manufactured before July 1, 1990, until July 1, 1998, even if it exceeds the standard in subsection (a). After July 1, 1998, a person must not use any [leafblower] <u>leaf blower</u> that violates the standard in subsection (a).
- (c) The Department must apply the standard in subsection (a) in accordance with the most current [leaf-blower] <u>leaf blower</u> testing standard of the American National Standards Institute (ANSI).
- (d) The Department may inspect, and [on] <u>at</u> its request a person must produce, any [leafblower] <u>leaf blower</u> that is sold, offered for sale, or used in the County, to determine whether the [leafblower] <u>leaf blower</u> complies with this section. A person who relies in good faith on a

31	(e)	Sale of combustion leaf removal equipment – prohibited. A person must		
32		not sell or offer for sale a combustion engine-powered handheld,

34	(f)	Use of combustion leaf removal equipment – prohibited. A person must		
35		not use a combustion engine-powered handheld, backpack, or walk-		
36		behind leaf blower or leaf vacuum.

38	(j)	Complaint and enforcement procedures. An enforcement officer may		
39		issue a civil citation under this Section if: [the Director receives a		
40	complaint of a noise disturbance supported by photographic evidence of			
41		a violation of subsection (f).]		
42		(1) the Director receives a complaint from at least one witness of a		
43		noise disturbance in violation of subsection (f); and		
44		(2) the complaint was received by the Director within 7 days of the		
45		alleged violation.

48	(f)	Except as provided in Section 31B-9(j), an enforcement officer may issue		
49		a civil citation for any violation of this Chapter if the enforcement officer:		
50		(1) witnesses the violation; or		
51		(2) receives complaints from at least 2 witnesses of a noise		
52		disturbance. Complaints by 2 witnesses are required to issue a		
53		citation under paragraph (2), but are not required to prove that a		
54		person violated this Chapter.		

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Sec. 2. Expedited Effective Date. The Council declares that this legislation is necessary for the immediate protection of the public interest. This Act takes effect on the date on which it becomes law.
