SUBJECT: Resolution to Support an Application submitted by Mobile Medical Care, Inc. to obtain \$20,000 in Tax Credits

Background

- 1. The State of Maryland's Department of Housing and Community Development (MDDHCD) has established the Community Investment Tax Credit Program.
- 2. The Community Investment Tax Credit Program (CITC) is a part of the Smart Growth initiative designed to promote efforts to support a variety of projects for special populations, to provide a source of funds for assistance, and to support projects undertaken by the nonprofit sector.
- 3. CITC provides tax credits to corporations that donate funds to nonprofit organizations that provide services and projects to special populations throughout the state.
- 4. Montgomery County supports the provision of quality primary health care for all County residents including low-income, unemployed, or uninsured populations.
- 5. Mobile Medical Care, Inc. (Mobile Med), a nonprofit organization, has been established in the County for over 45 years providing quality primary health care services with the use of vans and at multiple fixed clinic sites.
- 6. Mobile Med has applied to MDDHCD for an allocation of \$20,000 in tax credits for business entities that make contributions.
- 7. Mobile Med proposes to use tax credit proceeds to expand their health care services in Aspen Hill, Rockville and Fairland.
- 8. The County Executive and the County Council support the project and the application of Mobile Medical Care, Inc. for \$20,000 in tax credits. This support is given as specified in COMAR 5.14.01.05B(10)(a).
