COUNTY COUNCIL FOR MONTGOMERY COUNTY, MARYLAND

Lead Sponsor: Council President at the Request of the County Executive

AN EXPEDITED ACT to:

- (1) authorize the County Executive to extend the term of a voting member first appointed to the Board of Directors to coincide with the end of a fiscal year; and
- (2) generally amend the law governing the Montgomery County Economic Development Corporation.

By amending

Montgomery County Code
Chapter 30B, Economic Development
Section 30B-3

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following Act:

1 **Sec. 1. Section 30B-3 is amended as follows:**

2 **30B-3. Board of Directors.**

3 * * *

4 (b) Each voting member serves a 3-year term. The individual terms of the
5 voting members must be staggered. Of the voting members first
6 appointed, four must be appointed for a 1-year term, four must be
7 appointed for a 2-year term, and three must be appointed for a 3-year
8 term. The Executive may extend the term of a voting member first
9 appointed for an additional 6 months or less to coincide with the end of a
10 fiscal year. A voting member appointed to fill a vacancy serves the rest
11 of the unexpired term. A voting member continues in office until his or
12 her successor is appointed and confirmed.


14 **Sec. 2. Expedited Effective Date.**


