Any person aggrieved by an approval, denial, revocation or suspension of a bed and breakfast license or short-term rental license may appeal the decision to the Board of Appeals. The Board of Appeals must hold a hearing on the appeal within [[30]]60 days after the notice of appeal has been filed, and must act on the appeal within 30 days after the hearing.

### Sec. 2. Expedited Effective Date.
