The Board may delegate its duties to the Executive 11 Director or a similarly situated County employee as it deems appropriate 12 and consistent with its fiduciary duties in a written policy and procedure. If 13 14 the Board has prudently delegated its duties and monitored the delegation, the trustees must not be liable for an act or omission made by its delegate. 15 Sec. 2. **Expedited Effective Date.** 16 The Council declares that this legislation is necessary for the immediate 17 protection of the public interest.
