AN EXPEDITED ACT to:

- (1) rename the existing Department of Technology Services to the Department of Technology and Enterprise Business Solutions; and
- (2) generally amend the law concerning the Department of Technology and Enterprise Business Solutions.

16 (a) *Generally.* The purposes of the Department of Technology [Services]

20 Enterprise Business Solutions serves as the County’s Chief Information
21 Officer (CIO). The CIO, under the supervision of the Chief

24 **2-58E. Transmission facility coordination.**

- 26 (d) (1) The Director must convene a Transmission Facility Coordinating
27 Group and select a chair from among its members. The Group
28 consists of the Director's designee or contractor and a designee
29 of:

31 (B) the Office of Management and Budget;
32 (C) the cable television administrator in the Department of
33 Technology [Services] and Enterprise Business Solutions;
34 (D) the Department of Transportation;
35 (E) the Department of Permitting Services; and

62 (a) *Established.* The Cable and Communications Advisory Committee may

63 provide advice and recommendations to the County Executive, County

64 Council, and the Department of Technology [Services] and Enterprise

65 Business Solutions on all telecommunications issues, including the

66 administration of this Chapter and any franchise agreement or

67 application. The Committee must not engage in any advocacy activity

68 at the State or federal levels unless that activity is approved by the

69 Office of Intergovernmental Relations.

71 **11-4A. Unfair trade practices - Internet Access Services.**

73 (e) (1) The Department of Technology [Services] and Enterprise

74 Business Solutions may receive and investigate complaints of

75 violations of this Section. The Cable Compliance Commission

76 may adjudicate violations of this Section, as provided in Section
77 8A-31.

79 **Sec. 2. Transition.**

80 (a) Any functions performed by the Department of Technology Services
81 immediately before this Act takes effect are transferred to the
82 Department of Technology and Enterprise Business Solutions.

83 (b) References to the Department of Technology Services in any County
84 law, regulation, or contract means the Department Technology and
85 Enterprise Business Solutions.


86 **Sec. 3. Expedited Effective Date.**

87 The Council declares that this legislation is necessary for the immediate
88 protection of the public interest. This Act takes effect on the date it becomes
89 law.


