AN EXPEDITED ACT to:

- (1) increase the number of Special Projects Managers in the Office of the County Executive; and
- (2) generally amend the law governing personnel in Montgomery County.

By amending

Montgomery County Code
Chapter 2, Administration
Section 2-26

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following Act:

1 **Sec. 1. Section 2-26 is amended, as follows:**

2 **2-26. Non-merit positions.**

3 The following positions in the Office of the County Executive are non-merit
4 positions:

- 5 (a) 5 Directors of the Regional Services Centers;
- 6 (b) Director, Office of Community Partnerships;
- 7 (c) Director of Strategic Partnerships;
- 8 (d) 4 Assistant Chief Administrative Officers;
- 9 (e) 2 Special Projects [Manager] Managers; and
- 10 (f) Chief Labor Relations Officer.

11 **Sec. 2. Expedited Effective Date.** The Council declares that this legislation
12 is necessary for the immediate protection of the public interest. This Act takes effect
13 on the date on which it becomes law.

14 **Sec. 3. Sunset Date.** This Act must expire, and must have no further force or
15 effect, after {insert date 3 years from effective date}.
