- (2) change the compensation for Police Accountability Board (PAB) and Administrative Charging Committee (ACC) members; and
- (3) generally amend the language regarding the PAB and ACC.

34 **35-26. Trial Board.**

35 The County must compensate the civilian member of a trial board appointed by
 36 the Police Accountability Board at the rate of \$500 for each day spent in trial and each
 37 day spent in training.

38 **[[Sec. 2. Retroactive application:**

39 Section 35-26 applies retroactively to any trial board or training attended by the
 40 civilian member since July 1, 2022.]]

41 **[[Sec. 3.]] Sec. 2. Transition:**

42 Nothing in this Act can be applied to alter the salary of a current member of the
 43 Board or the Committee during that member’s current term except for salary changes
 44 resulting from (1) CPI-based salary adjustments, (2) the movement of a current
 45 member to or from the position of Chair after the effective date of this Act, or (3) the
 46 movement of a current member to or from the position of Board representative on the
 47 Committee after the effective date of this Act.
