- (1) amend the amount paid to recipients under the Working Families Income Supplement Program; and
- (2) generally amend the Working Families Income Supplement Program.

By amending

Montgomery County Code
Chapter 20, Finance
Article XIV, Working Families Income Supplement
Section 20-79

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following Act:

1 **Sec. 1. Section 20-79 is amended as follows:**

2 **20-79. Amount of Supplement.**

3 The amount of the Working Families Income Supplement paid to each
4 recipient must equal [the amount] ~~[[67%]]~~ the amount of any refund the recipient
5 receives from the State earned income credit program or another amount approved
6 in the annual operating budget or a Council resolution. [[The Executive, by
7 regulations issued under Method (1), may increase the amount of the
8 Supplement.]]

9 **Sec. 2. Expedited Effective Date.**

10 The Council declares that this legislation is necessary for the immediate
11 protection of the public interest. This Act takes effect on the date on which it
12 becomes law.




