- (1) alter the membership on the Advisory Board for the Montgomery Cares Program;
and
- (2) generally amend County law concerning the Advisory Board for the Montgomery Cares Program.

By amending

Montgomery County Code
Chapter 24, Health and Sanitation
Section 24-50

1 **Sec. 1. Section 24-50 is amended as follows:**

2 **24-50. Members; appointments; terms.**

3 (a) *Total members.* The Board has [15] 17 members.

4 * * *

5 (c) *Other members.* Subject to confirmation by the County Council, the
6 County Executive should appoint the following individuals to serve
7 on the Board:

8 (1) 2 representatives of community health care providers that
9 participate in the Program;

10 (2) 1 representative of hospitals that participate in the Program;

11 (3) The chair of the Board of Directors of the entity that contracts
12 with the Department to administer the distribution of funds for
13 the delivery of Program services or the chair's designee;

14 (4) 3 members of the public[, who may be current or former
15 recipients of services under the Program];

16 (5) 4 individuals who have knowledge of and experience with
17 issues relating to health care for uninsured individuals such as
18 primary care, specialty care, dental care, behavioral health care,
19 or fiscal matters relating to any of these types of care;

20 (6) 1 representative of the Commission on Health; and


21 (7) 1 representative of the County Medical Society[.]; and

22 (8) 2 current or former recipients of services under the Program.
