Sec. 2. Chapter 8 of the 2007 Laws of Montgomery County is amended as follows:

Continuity and sunset of Pedestrian and Traffic Safety Advisory 35 Committee. Section 49-81 establishes a Pedestrian and Traffic Safety Advisory 36 Committee. This Committee continues the Pedestrian Safety Advisory Committee, 37 38 created under Council Resolution 14-1281 and extended under Council Resolution 16-192. The County Executive must allow the members of the Pedestrian Safety 39 Advisory Committee to continue to serve the remainder of their terms as members of 40 the Pedestrian and Traffic Safety Advisory Committee. The Executive must continue 41 42 to stagger the terms of the members of the Pedestrian and Traffic Safety Advisory Committee so that approximately one-third of the terms of these members continue 43 to expire each year. [Section 49-81 expires on August 31, 2012.] 44 45
