1           **Sec. 1.           Section 2-43 of the County Code is amended as follows:**

2   **2-43. Organization and functions.**

3           The Department of Police includes the County police, Division of County  
4 Security, and the Animal Services Division. The Department has the authority,  
5 functions and activities prescribed by law.


6           [Three] Four positions of Assistant Chief of Police are non-merit positions.

7           Any reference in this Code or in regulation or other document to  
8 “superintendent of police” or “superintendent” means “Director of Police,” or “Chief  
9 of Police,” or “Director”.


10           **Sec. 2.           Expedited Effective Date.**

13 becomes law.


