The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following Act:

1 **Sec. 1. Section 2 of Chapter 34 of the Laws of Montgomery County**
2 **2013 is amended as follows:**

3 **Sec. 2. Transition.**

4 Notwithstanding Section 27-68, as added in Section 1, the County minimum
5 wage, until [October] July 1, 2017, must be the greater of the minimum wage
6 required under the Federal or State Act or:

- 7 (a) effective October 1, 2014, \$8.40 per hour;
- 8 (b) effective [October] ~~[[July]]~~ October 1, 2015, \$9.55 per hour; and
- 9 (c) effective [October] July 1, 2016, \$10.75 per hour.
