AN EXPEDITED ACT to:

- (1) extend the time for the Executive to submit an economic development strategic plan for the County to the Council;
- (2) generally amend the law governing the economic development strategic plan.

By amending

Montgomery County Code
Chapter 20, Finance
Section 20-76

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following Act:

1 **Sec. 1. Section 20-76 is amended as follows:**

2 **20-76. Economic Development Strategic Plan, Administration.**

3 (a) The Executive must submit, by method 1 regulation, an economic
4 development strategic plan for the County to the Council for approval on
5 or before [July 1, 2015] October 1, 2015 and each fourth year thereafter.
6 The success or progress of the strategic plan must be measurable and the
7 plan must include measures to address:

- 8 (1) job creation;
- 9 (2) private sector compensation and benefits;
- 10 (3) target industries;
- 11 (4) target geographic areas;
- 12 (5) workforce education and training;
- 13 (6) growth in tax base;
- 14 (7) economic opportunity for residents;
- 15 (8) encouragement of entrepreneurs and small business;
- 16 (9) land use; and
- 17 (10) other actions necessary to promote economic development in the
18 County.

20 **Sec. 2. Expedited Effective Date.**

21 The Council declares that this legislation is necessary for the immediate
22 protection of the public interest. This Act takes effect on the date on which it becomes
23 law.
